PATHWAYS TERMINOLOGY

Areas of Study

The eight broad areas identified by the Pathways Phase 1 CWT. An area of study presents faculty and administration in that area with the opportunity to design a more structured and coherent experience for students.

Area of Study Maps

A guided program of study within an Area of Study. It supplies students with a plan based on developmental support from the college.

Schedule

Courses that the student enrolls in based on the Area of Study Map.

Learning Destination

The knowledge, skills, concepts, and habits of mind that a student will acquire as a result of successful completion.
