NEW APPROACH ACADEMIC ADVISING

Intrusive Advising

Indicators - Proactive outreach, mandatory check-ins, clear and individual guidance, catching matches before they turn into forest fires

Outcomes - Increased student support, higher completion rates, more timely completion, deeper understanding of academic advising's role

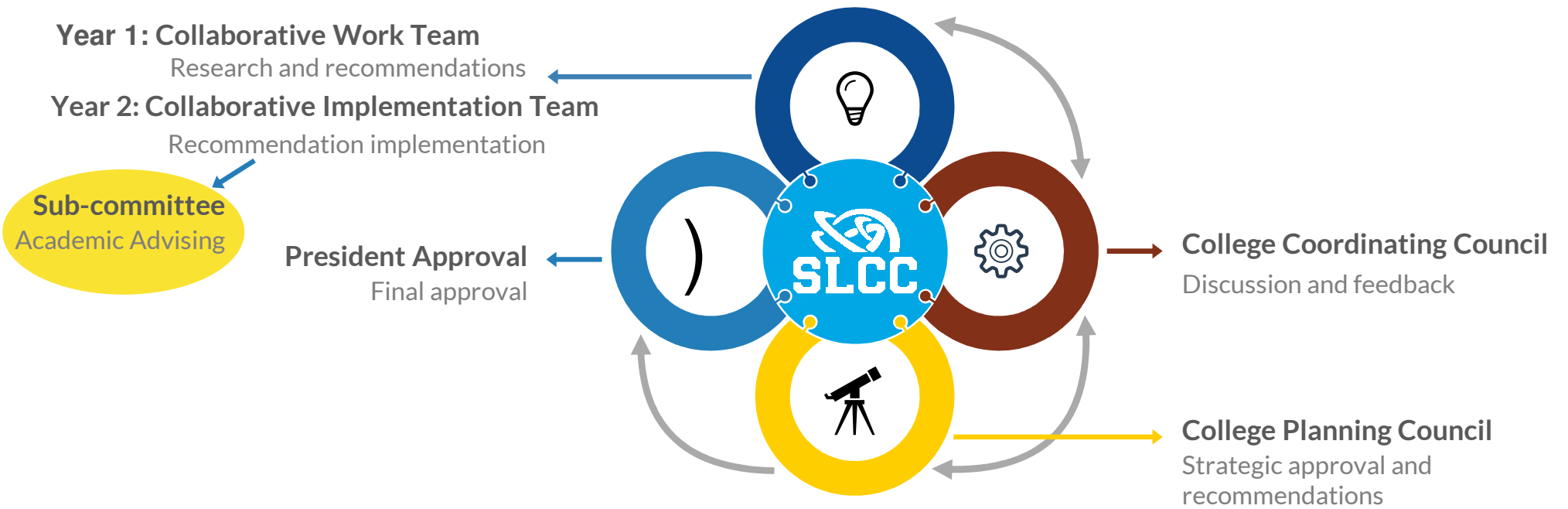

PATHWAYS TERMINOLOGY

MySuccess Plan

A MySuccess plan is the knowledge, experiences, and abilities a student must have in order to successfully navigate Salt Lake Community College from the time they enroll to when they complete their identified purpose for attending the college.

The term “academic plan” leads to confusion because it is used synonymously with “degree plan” or the courses a student must successfully complete to graduate. The sub-committee recommends that SLCC refer to an academic plan as a “MySuccess Plan”.

MYSUCCESS COLLEGE-WIDE

MySuccess planning is a cross-departmental, cross-divisional effort to guide students through the College as efficiently as possible while achieving our college-wide learning goals and best preparing students for their next step.

GET READY TO REGISTER

ADMISSIONS TO ENROLLMENT

- ▶ Facilitate mandatory group advising at Orientation
- ▶ Review types of programs and program maps
- ▶ Use DegreeWorks to verify program of study and plan courses
- ▶ Demonstrate using MySLCC to register for class and pay tuition
- ▶ Connect student to departmental meet-and-greets with Academic Deans and/or Faculty

GOAL SETTING & DEGREE PLANNING

1ST SEMESTER OR 25% COMPLETION

- ▶ Facilitate mandatory one-on-one advising session
- ▶ Discuss personalized goals, strengths, & challenges
- ▶ Create individualized degree plan to completion
- ▶ Encourage students to create a financial plan
- ▶ Embed advising principles within “gateway” courses

TRANSFER & CAREER PLANNING

2ND SEMESTER OR 50% COMPLETION

- ▶ Facilitate optional one-on-one advisor meeting about transferring to university for AS or AA seekers
- ▶ Facilitate mandatory advising for Early Alert & Academic Standards interventions
- ▶ Connect student to career exploration activities in academic school
- ▶ Outreach to students who have not re-enrolled

PREPARING TO GRADUATE

3RD SEMESTER OR 75% COMPLETION

- ▶ Facilitate mandatory one-on-one advising meeting to discuss graduation plan
- ▶ Aid student with graduation application & transfer institution application if needed
- ▶ Connect student to Career Services for job search & employment preparation
- ▶ Connect student to optional financial planning for continued education

PREPARING TO WORK

4TH SEMESTER OR 100% COMPLETION

- ▶ Facilitate optional one-on-one advising meeting to verify graduation & transfer plans
- ▶ Outreach to students who have not applied for graduation
- ▶ Facilitate required one-on-one advising meeting for students who are off-track
