#### FY 23 Budget Process Outcomes May 9, 2022

The Executive Cabinet finalized the 2022-23 operating budget decisions closing this year's Informed Budget Process (IBP). IBP relies on the college community's input in reviewing budgetary needs to make the best decisions. The institutional budget decisions rely heavily on new legislative appropriations and this legislative session was very positive for SLCC and public higher education.

For 2022-23, the College will receive new, ongoing funds to support the following areas: compensation, performance-based projects aligned with our goals, and significant increases to the newly renamed Salt Lake Technical College (former SAT). The Executive Cabinet also decided to use institutional reserves and new tuition dollars to offset the inflationary costs of health insurance to lessen the impact on employees. Lastly, many of this year's funding decisions were made to accommodate declining fee revenues and move positions or other costs to appropriated funds noted below by "change of revenue source."

The final 2022-23 IBP base funded decisions are organized below by institutional goal. The full detail of base funded and one-time funded requests, organized by Division, are on the attached pages.

## **Budget Reductions**

Cabinet also made critical decisions on reducing the tuition side of the operating budget by cutting \$3.6 million in committed expenditures to offset the enrollment decline. In budget terms, we have an FTE enrollment target to obtain the necessary tuition revenue. This reduction effort moved us from a 14,500 annualized student FTE target to 13,350 FTE. The reductions will come from the following areas:

- SLCC Operation & Maintenance (Facilities); and Leases: \$1.25 million
- Open Positions & Current Expense Budgets across Divisions: \$2.35 million

Reduction decisions will be finalized by Cabinet on May 17 and communicated by the respective Divisional Vice President to their employees. Efforts were made to maintain

core operational structures and to position the College for better use of new institutional funding. Every Division received some level of budget reduction.

Thanks to all of you who participated in the annual Informed Budget Process. The input is needed to make the best-informed decisions. I would also like to thank Dr. Darren Marshall, AVP Budget and Planning, Jillana AhLoe, Budget Director, and Lisa Fowler, interim AVP People Workplace and Culture.
