Colleagues,

Thank you for participating in the 2023-24 Informed Budget Process. Your input has helped the Executive Cabinet consider and finalize the 2023-24 operating budget. New legislative appropriations provided the funding to support compensation, key initiatives, and assisted with covering budget shortfalls. This legislative session was very positive for SLCC and public higher education.

For 2023-24, the Executive Cabinet decided to cover all increases to health and dental insurance premiums to decrease the burden on employees. Cabinet also decided to set aside \$1,300,000 for salary equity as part of a larger compensation strategy to bring salaries up to market. These funds are planned for distribution in Fall 2023. We have made no increases to tuition and general student fees as part of a broader Utah System of Higher Education agreement with the Governor and Legislature. And finally, this year we utilized the Equity Compass to consider budget priorities and decisions and strengthen our work around equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI) initiatives to help more students succeed.

The final 2023-24 IBP base-funded decisions are organized below by institutional goal with an "(EDI)" note for those applicable positions or programs. The full detail of base-funded and one-time funded requests, organized by SLCC division or by Salt Lake Technical College, are on the attached documents.
