# • Helium Balloons

Helium Balloons are strictly prohibited in the buildings listed below. If they get loose they will set the fire alarm off due to beam detectors near the ceilings

# Inside ALL Buildings on ALL Campuses

- Posters and advertising may be placed on designated bulletin boards, tack strips and plastic sign holders. All posters not on bulletin boards must be posted by blue tape. <u>No pins, tacks, or</u> <u>nails may be put into any walls.</u>
- Doors are not posting areas, do not use.

# • Outside

- Garbage cans ok if you use blue tape
- Sidewalk chalk ok to use only on sidewalks
- o Stakes ok, wood only, <u>no rebar</u>
  - Must be 2 feet from sidewalks
  - No laminated posters on the ground
  - No flyers, handouts, posters, etc. on cars
  - o Trees
    - No stapling to trees
    - Fishing line and string ok (preferably twine) just make sure you remove it, or it will damage the tree
    - Be cautious with weight
  - Grass strips in between the double sidewalks have plastic in them and the Facilities Division discourages using stakes there.
  - All wood signs need to be self-supported and placed only 2 feet from sidewalks, if there is not 2 feet, then do not attempt to place a stake there.
  - You can attach lightweight signs to fencing (up to 4' x 8' max)
  - Do no attach anything to existing signage
  - o Do not attach anything to artwork/sculptures
  - Do not attach anything to the marquis on any campus
  - o Helium balloons may be placed outside
- Attaching to lamps posts is ok (do not cover existing banners and use blue tape only)
