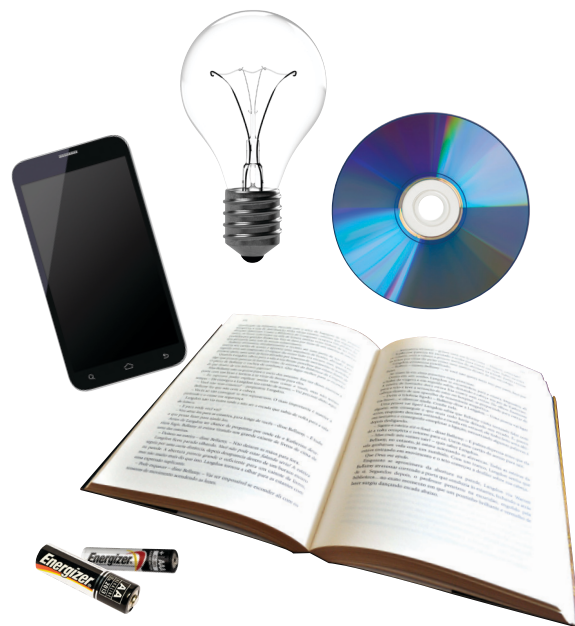


Additional Items We Recycle

- Used toner cartridges are accepted and preferred in a box. Place next to recycling bin.
- Books
- Batteries (in designated battery boxes)
- Cell phones (placed in the bin located in the Student Center main entrance at Taylorsville Redwood Campus)
- Three ring binders, hanging file folders and notebooks
- CDs and floppy disks
- Metal
- Light bulbs
- Pallets

Please contact SLCC Recycling for any large recycling projects, including office cleanouts, cardboard and book recycling.

RECYCLING *is easy!*

This guide will help clarify what is accepted for recycling at SLCC and what needs to be thrown away.
Contact your local recycler with questions about what can be recycled at home.

To help us achieve our goal of sustainability, please remember that ***everything put in the recycle bins needs to be clean. No food or grease are allowed on items.***

Please remember to ***always use the correctly labeled bin.***

Plastic

Clean hard plastics are accepted. With plastic bottles, the caps can be on or off. A small amount of liquid left inside is okay.

Yogurt containers are accepted—please make sure they're rinsed and clean.



Not recyclable:

Thin plastics such as grocery bags, trash bags, plastic bags, plastic shipping packaging, bubble wrap and saran wrap are not accepted. Local grocery stores will accept used bags.

Styrofoam and plastic utensils are not accepted at SLCC.

Candy bar wrappers and chip bags are not accepted. Their multiple layers cannot be separated during the recycling process.



Paper

Unlaminated, clean and dry paper—including all newspaper and magazines. Paper clips, staples and plastic windows are accepted.

Clean non-waxed cardboard is also accepted.



Not recyclable:

Paper towels, tissues and napkins, either clean or dirty, are not recyclable. Greasy cardboard, such as the bottom of a pizza box, is not recyclable at SLCC.

Many paper cups, plates and bowls, including fast-food containers and coffee cups are lined with a plastic film and cannot be recycled. Most coffee cups are not recyclable, but their lids and cardboard sleeves are. Milk, juice and all similar cartons are not accepted at SLCC.



Metals, Glass, etc.

Clean aluminum and steel cans are accepted. Please make sure they're empty.

Unbroken glass is accepted on all but the Miller, South City, Herriman and Jordan campuses.



Not recyclable:

Disposable gloves are not accepted.
No string or pens accepted.
