








Reach is the Total Number of Unique Viewers/Readers; UVPM is the Total Number of Unique Viewers Across Social Platforms

I had a conversation recently with a high school senior stressed out about college. He was a disappointed that the local community college was his most likely destination. He wanted "bigger things" for his future. I know exactly how he feels because twenty years ago, I was him.

I told him my story. I remember applying to the same schools as my friends and seeing them get full ride scholarship offers while my mailbox was empty. I felt that a community college was below me, and I was wrong.

I got my start at Salt Lake Community College and it was one of the biggest blessings of my life. I loved the people I met, the professors that taught me and the opportunities it gave me. At the community college I felt visible. I had a friend who attended the state school and his freshman chemistry class had 300 people in it, mine had 30. My professor knew my name.

I worked hard at SLCC and graduated with a transfer degree and good enough grades to earn a full ride transfer scholarship at the University of Utah. I eventually went on to get a PhD from the University of Washington. It wasn't the path I envisioned at 18, but I am grateful for the journey.
