
Fully online degree programs

Which programs have the highest proportion of online credits at graduation?



Percent of awards that were completed fully online, 2017-2018



Percent of students retained from Fall 2017 to Fall 2018 Declared program may have changed; students who graduated before Fall 2018 are excluded





Percent of current students outside Salt Lake County, Spring 2019



Age of current students at 3rd-week census, Spring 2019


